Walsall Domestic Violence Forum has been delivering multi-agency training in the Borough of Walsall since 1999, due to the success of our training we are pleased to be able to offer the programme across the West Midlands.

Module 1: Domestic Abuse Awareness

Designed to give a broad understanding of Domestic Abuse, our 'entry level' course, ideally you should complete this course before moving on to the other modules. Participants will gain insight into:

- What exactly is Domestic Abuse? Exploration of the myths and stereotypes.
- Facts and statistics about Domestic Abuse.
- The impact of Domestic Abuse.
- The Police perspective.
- Safety Planning.

Module 2: Domestic Abuse & Child Protection

In response to many requests for further training in more specialist areas we worked with Walsall Local Safeguarding Children's Board and developed a specific programme to address the very important area of Child Protection.

- Abuse of children.
- Responsibilities and referrals.
- How children are drawn in.

Module 3: Supporting Victims

Designed to show best practice in supporting victims of Domestic Abuse, participants will gain understanding of:

- The difficulties faced by people speaking out about Domestic Abuse.
- How to empower victims to make informed choices.
- Assisting victims in recognising their vulnerabilities.
- Understanding the roles of service providers.

Module 4: Adult Protection

This course was developed in conjunction with Safeguarding Adult Services in accordance with National Guidance around Adult Protection and addresses specific issues to be considered by those working with vulnerable adults and includes:

- Who is a vulnerable adult?
- Indicators of abuse.
- Responsibilities and referrals.

Module 5: Working With Men

This course has been developed to explore working with men in three key areas.

- Working with men who present as victims of abuse.
- Working with men who present as perpetrators of abuse.
- Referral pathways.
